Riding in our authentic Old West wagons will captivate and charm you as much as our zoo. These 100-year-old wagons, which date from the days of the first pioneers, are pulled by teams of Percheron draft horses weighing over one ton each.

The bird sanctuary nestled by the lake is an oasis where visitors can savor quiet moments of reflection. The flocks of winged creatures populating the sanctuary are a bird-watcher's delight.

At the farm you can learn about organic gardening. Our organically grown vegetables, fruits and berries are so fresh, wholesome, and appetizing, you might be tempted to take some with you. You may also want to pick up a few of Young Living's carefully-nurtured herb starts to plant in your gardens at home so you can enjoy their intoxicating aromas and the beauty they bring to your surroundings.

There are tours that last 30 to 60 minutes, which include the greenhouses, herb fields, distillery, petting zoo, bird sanctuary and Visitors Center. There are also rides for the children in the little wagon pulled by miniature horses. A visit to the farm will be fun for the entire family!
